Lewis County tax notices to be sent out beginning today

CHEHALIS – The Lewis County Treasurers' Office on Wednesday began mailing real and personal property tax statements to residents.

Taxes can be paid in person at the Treasurer's Office on the first floor of the Historic Lewis County Courthouse, 351 NW North Street in Chehalis or mailed to P.O. Box 509, Chehalis WA 98532. There are payment drop boxes located outside of the courthouse on NW North St. and in the lobby of the courthouse. Payments can also be made electronically by clicking [here](#).

Treasurer Army Davis reminds taxpayers to make sure if mailing your payment that the postmark is dated on or before the due date in order to avoid a late payment charge. State law requires fees be imposed for late payment. The county Treasurer's Office is open 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

There are many factors that influence the amount of property taxes owed, including taxes approved by voters and increases imposed by taxing districts as allowed by state law, plus the assessed valuation of property.

Most taxes are calculated using a budget-based system of property taxation for taxing districts, with some exceptions. Under the budget-based system, a taxing district establishes the amount of property tax revenue needed to fund their budget. The amount needed to fund the budget is called the levy amount. It is the total amount to be collected from the taxpayers by a taxing district.

The total value of properties in Lewis County is 15,809,372,698.
