CURRENT & FUTURE CRITICAL AIRCRAFT

• 2022-2042 Critical Aircraft: Cessna 182 (AAC/ADG: A-I Small) – typical single engine piston weighing 12,500 pounds or less.

The 2017 ALP includes development reserves to preserve the ability to accommodate large business class aircraft (multi-engine turboprop and jets), common to ADG II.







Runway 06/24 / Airfield

- Complete Lighting Upgrades to LED
 - -Runway Edge Lights (MIRL)
 - -Runway End Identifier Lights (REIL)
 - -Visual Guidance Indicators (PAPI/VASI)
 - -Airport Beacon
- Approach Obstruction Clearance -
 - –Runway 6 Clearance for vehicles traveling on Buckley Road (2017 ALP)







Runway 06/24 / Airfield

- -Maintain Runway Width (2017 ALP)
- -Maintain East Runway & Parallel Taxiway Extension Reserve (2017 ALP)
- Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS)







Terminal Area

 Aboveground Aircraft Fuel Storage Tanks, Pump System (New/Replacement), and Designated Fueling Area

Terminal Area

- Main Apron Taxilanes (ADG I standards) – Modify for clearances between parked and fueling aircraft, hangars, etc. Long term apron development.
- Aircraft Storage Hangars and Commercial Hangars (aircraft maintenance, etc.).
- GA Terminal/Fixed Base Operator (FBO) Building
 - Airport Restaurant, FBO Hangar, Pilot Services, Airport Office







Terminal Area


- Hangar Taxilanes Reconstruct/Repave based on ADG I standards
- Water and sanitary sewer service upgrades/extensions






