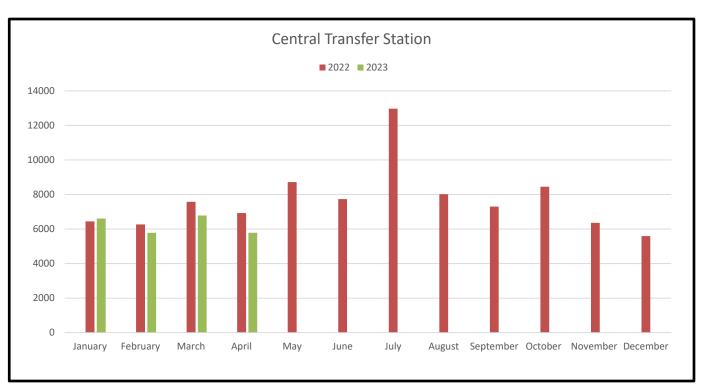

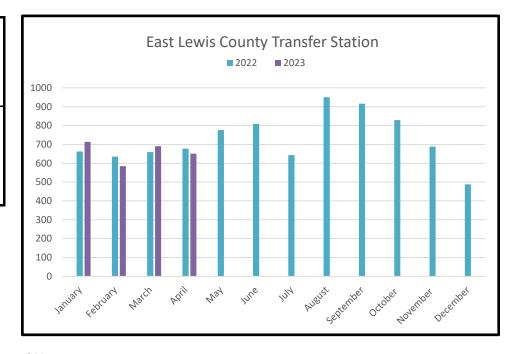

CTS monthly rent payment increased from \$38,700 to \$51,000 in January 2010. \$38,700 goes toward a bond payment and \$12,300 is reserved in Solid Waste Fund 401 for capital improvements. Per BOCC Resolution #19-292, when the bond is fully paid in December 2024, the entire \$51,000 payment will be accounted for in the Solid Waste capital improvement reserve.
